(PLAI) will be conducting its annual National Congress with the theme Libraries: Preservers and Promoters of Culture and Arts to be held at Punta Villa Resort, Arevalo, Iloilo City on November 20-22, 2013. This Congress is co-sponsored by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) through the National Committee on Libraries and Information Services (NCLIS) and the National Library of the Philippines.
